Young schools boys often indulge in passing lewd comments like these, which gives them a sense of masculinity and control. The people around passively participate, as it probably satisfies a voyeuristic need in them. If you don't object, the behaviour is reinforced and the perpetrator has a further sense of gratification. Your anger in this situation is justified. Please don't feel guilty in any way. When you confront elements like these, your body language should be assertive, with clear eye contact explicitly supporting your intense discomfort. If the situation demands, report to the authorities.


Hi, I am looking for tea shops where I can find different varieties of tea, such as, white tea, green tea and chamomile tea. I would want to gift them to friends staying abroad.
